Required Qualifications

Earned doctorate required in Instructional Systems Technology, School Library Media, Distance Learning, Educational Research, Program Evaluation, or related field. Qualified candidates also must have a record of teaching, scholarship, and service in higher education sufficient to qualify for rank of Associate or Full Professor and secure tenure. Candidates must have: ability to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in the department and in other departments as appropriate; experience or demonstrated potential to lead effectively a diverse and dynamic academic department including evaluation and development of academic faculty and staff; ability to develop, support, and manage new programs including distance, on-line, and other alternative delivery programs; and demonstrated ability and interest in developing and supporting cross-departmental and cross-college programs.

Preferred Qualifications

Preferred candidates will have three or more years of P-12 classroom and/or administrative experience; demonstrated potential to secure, encourage, and manage externally-funded projects, ability to develop and administer high quality graduate programs, experience in leading or assisting with successful program and unit accreditation, and understanding of the effective use of evaluation and data for program development and improvement.
