Required Qualifications

Earned doctorate in Physical Education or related field from an accredited institution by August 15, 2011. Preference will be given to candidates with both higher education teaching experience and experience working in public schools, private schools and/or sport academies. The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses and graduate courses in physical education and a variety of activity courses in the personal wellness, lifelong activities area as assigned by the chair. Specific activity skills and certifications are desirable. The candidate will initiate or continue significant professional involvement and an active scholarship agenda of applied research, publication and grant writing. Participation in department, college and community service is expected.

Preferred Qualifications

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate the ability to innovatively deliver contemporary classroom experiences. Preference will be given to candidates with both higher education teaching experience and a practical experience in the sport industry.
