Department of Leadership and Applied Instruction seeks qualified candidates for the position of Assistant Professor of Secondary/Elementary Math Education, 10 month, tenure track position with the possibility of summer employment. Position begins August 2011 pending funding. Salary \$50,000 for 10 month contract.

Required Qualifications

Earned doctorate in Mathematics Education from an accredited institution by August 15, 2011. Candidates must have excellent verbal and written communication skills and demonstrated commitment to teaching, service, and research. Candidates must have the ability to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Elementary and Secondary Math Education in face to face and online environments, have an emerging research/publication agenda, and be willing to work some evenings and weekends. Terminal degree must be awarded prior to position starting date. Participation in department, university and community service is expected.

Preferred Qualifications

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate the ability to innovatively deliver contemporary classroom experiences. Preference will be given to candidates with both higher education teaching experience and a minimum of three years K-12 classroom experience.
